Today, an eight-year-old in Cambodia celebrates her birthday because of Kiwanians like us. Eight years ago, UNICEF bought tetanus vaccine and conducted a vaccination campaign in Cambodia with the first dollars raised through The Eliminate Project.

This World Immunization Week, we can say our club proudly supports for mass immunization for every child around the world. Every day, 15,000 children die, many from preventable causes like neonatal tetanus.

"Vaccines and mass immunization are one of the safest, most effective, and most cost-efficient public health interventions available," said 2017-18 Kiwanis International President Jim Rochford. "We have seen firsthand that vaccines save and improve lives — look at the success of The Eliminate Project."

According to data from the World Health Organization, neonatal tetanus killed about 34,000 newborn children in 2015, a 96% reduction from 1988, when an estimated 787,000 newborn babies died of tetanus within their first month of life. Today, women and babies in just

## Batesville, Ark., contest cancelled due to local flooding

Flood waters engulfed Riverside Park in Batesville, Ark., the site of the 2009 Ozark Hawg BBQ Championship. The flood waters reached the roof eaves of the Firefighter's Training Center where blind judging and judges hospitality are housed and were not expected to exit the park until a few days before the event. Due to the dangers from unsanitary conditions and lack of any possible hope for a sound foundation for the team area, BBQ Chair Lyndal Waits and Kiwanis President Janie Starnes officially cancelled the event originally slated for March 28-29, 2009. Lyndal placed a press release on the event's website outlining the decision. Lyndal and Janie tried to secure an alternate location for the contest but had no success.

Due to conflicts of time, the contest will not be rescheduled for a later date this year. However, plans for the 2009

contest are already underway. Please make plans to attend the 2009 Ozark Hawg BBQ Championship with the rest of the teams and judges.
