This Saturday is the day for this year's Kiwanis Christmas Parade. This Year's Theme is "An Old-Fashioned Christmas" and we need our Kiwanians to help. Please plan on attending and helping to make this Parade a success.

The Missouri-Arkansas District Board of Directors has approved a club membership competition, which started November 1.

All clubs in the district compete in one of two divisions based on membership as of Nov. 1. Clubs with 30 or more members will compete in Division A; clubs with fewer than 30 in Division B.

Grants will be awarded for percentage membership increase from Nov. 1 to March 31 as follows: first place, \$4,000; second, \$3,000; third, \$2,000; and fourth, \$1,000. Division B prizes will be the same but to account for the larger number of clubs, three \$1,000

Tablet of Honor

The award was established in 1965 to memorialize individuals and organizations for outstanding service to their community and the world's largest civic club. It also signifies that \$2,000 has been made to the international club's endowment fund on behalf of the individual or organization.

The Tablet of Honor is the highest honor a club can bestow upon a member. This award requires a donation of at least \$2,000 to the International Kiwanis Foundation. Individuals cannot honor themselves.

George F. Hixson Fellows

In 1983, the Kiwanis Children's Fund established the George F. Hixson Fellowship. Named for Kiwanis International's first president, Hixson Fellowships are awarded to donors who give US\$1,000 or more to the Children's Fund. It's a way of recognizing people who have contributed significantly to Kiwanis' history of generosity. In fact, clubs and Kiwanians often give in honor of another person or organization—recognizing others' help and commitment with a Hixson Fellowship.
